Shared Solar - Dominion

Policy proposal: Expanding the shared solar program for Dominion Energy Virginia

- Description:**
- Directs the utility to release additional program capacity by July 1, 2026 or earlier, until the program reaches 6 percent of the utility's adjusted Virginia peak-load forecast for the previous year.
 - o 275MW shall serve projects with 100 percent low-income customers.
 - o Remainder shall serve projects with more than 51 percent low-income customers.
 - Directs the SCC to establish a minimum bill by December 31, 2026.
 - By January 1, 2030 or earlier, the SCC will conduct a shared solar program expansion proceeding, and every three years thereafter.
 - Allows subscriber organizations to distribute excess bill credits more frequently than once per year.
 - Requires Dominion to file any tariffs, agreements, or forms necessary for implementation of such shared solar programs by March 1, 2027.
