- Formed to administer Virginia Health Care Data Reporting Initiatives to benefit Virginians






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# Representing All Health Care Stakeholders To Benefit Consumers, Business and Others






## **Psychiatric Bed Registry**




Purpose: Help identify potentially available psychiatric beds


- Private and state hospitals and CSBs with Crisis Stabilization Units to update # of psychiatric beds on website
- CSBs contact facilities meeting search criteria to discuss whether services available will meet patient needs



<u>Status:</u> Website & training tools developed & implemented; project manager @ DBHDS hired; 2011/2012 contract drafted

<u>Next Steps:</u> DBHDS to update psych personnel contact list; promote and release site, develop management reports and/or export utility







# Virginia's Crash Outcome Data Evaluation System (CODES)



- A partnership with the Department of Motor Vehicles Highway Safety Office
- Combines Police Crash Reports with hospital discharge data and other sources to better describe the burden of motor vehicle crashes
- By city/county, vehicle type, major factor
- Can help support traffic safety policy and legislation





### **Strategic Plan Paves the Way**



#### 1. Health Care Reform

Play a principle role in new opportunities for collection, analyses and sharing of additional health care information resulting from health reform initiatives

#### 2. Government Relations

Create value for legislators by enabling them to respond to the public's need for expanded and valid health care information prepared by and distributed by VHI in a reliable and unbiased manner

#### 3. Board Governance and VHI Administration

Advance VHI's mission through Board of Directors governance, leadership and commitment

#### 4. Sales/Income Producing

Assure the financial viability of VHI through the production and sale of products and services that meet the needs of the public and health care organizations for accurate and unbiased health care information that enables them to make informed decisions

#### 5. Public Awareness & Communication

Significantly increase the public's awareness of VHI's mission and the data, products services available to the public, health care providers and insurers and to achieve a high level of recognition of VHI throughout the state by consumers and providers of health care

# APCD- All Payer Claims Database Under Consideration in Virginia



Typically includes data from medical, pharmacy, and dental claims with eligibility and provider files:

- Used to analyze health system performance
- Monitor and focus public health efforts
- Public reporting of health care cost and quality
- VHI serves as a resource to the Virginia Health Reform Initiative (VHRI) and JCHC Healthy Living Subcommittee
