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## **Data Systems**

- Infant and Toddler Online Tracking System (ITOTS)
  - □ System enhancements started in 2005
  - □ Part C early intervention program data
- Virginia Infant Screening and Infant Tracking System (VISITS)
  - □ Birth defects registry
  - □ Early hearing detection and intervention



## **Background**

- Current system has not kept pace with changing data requirements at the state and federal level
- Elements of the data system need to be enhanced or replaced

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## **Background**

- ITOTS and VISITS do not share a universal identifier
- Current system enhancements include creating capacity for linkage of referrals from VISITS to ITOTS



### **Current Status – ITOTS**

- Collects three prematurity measures:
  - □ less than 28 weeks,
  - □ 28-31 weeks, and
  - □ 32-37 weeks
- DMHMRSAS initiated changes to ITOTS that included child's name and social security number and changed report generation parameters

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### **Current Status – ITOTS**

- ITOTS currently collects very low birth weight of less than 1500g
- Version 1.5 planned for release Mid November and will add low birth weight (1500g to <2500g or 3.5 lbs to <5.5 lbs)</li>



## **Next Steps**

- ITOTS on-going system re-design includes enhancements necessary to meet
  - ☐ State reporting requirements
  - □ Federal reporting requirements
    - 619 data (child data)
    - State Performance Report
- June 2009

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## **Future Reporting Capacity**

- Include in both ITOTS and VISITS II databases child's actual
  - Birth weight
  - □ Gestational age
- Link Part C data on children's diagnosed conditions and services to VISITS II



#### **Future Under Enhanced ITOTs**

- ITOTS collects data about child progress in three functional areas:
  - □ Social-emotional skills and relationships
  - □ Acquiring and using knowledge and skills
  - □ Taking appropriate action to meet needs

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#### **Future Under Enhanced ITOTs**

- ITOTS could report data on selected developmental outcomes up to age 2 for LBW/preterm infants
  - □ Prematurity risk factors and/or
  - □ Low or very low birth weight



## Example- ITOTS Report (under development)

Reports the Number and Percent of Infants and Toddlers in Part C with any combination of low/very low birth weight and/or prematurity risk factor
