- DHS consolidation introduced additional electronic sources of information
- New enforcement information resources are added to the search protocol as they become available

- Prepare and submit response



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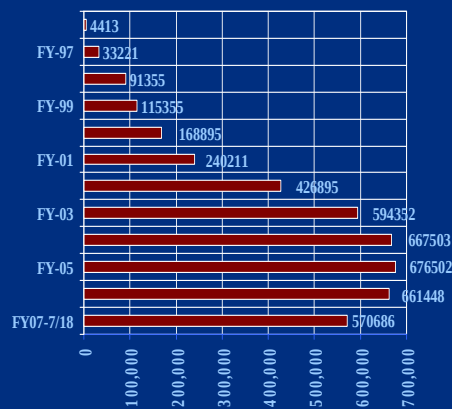

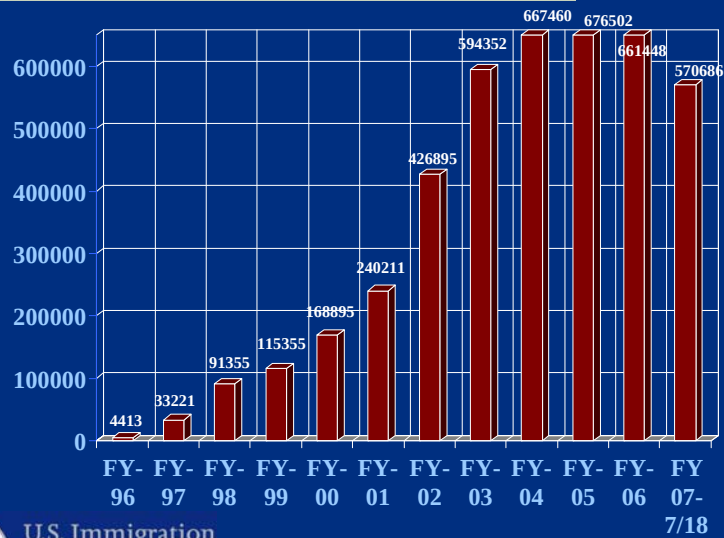
Law Enforcement Support Center Query Processing



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- 1996 LESC pilot begins in Phoenix
3 states have IAQ online
- 1997 5 states have IAQ online
- 1998 LESC begins support of FBI NICS Operation
16 states have IAQ online
- 1999 30 states have IAQ online
- 2000 LESC establishes national NCIC program
34 states have IAQ online
- 2001 50 states have IAQ online
- 2001 LESC begins support to U.S. Secret Service
- 2003 1-866-DHS-2-ICE tip-line established
- 2007 LESC anticipates 1,000,000 or more contacts from
law enforcement and the public

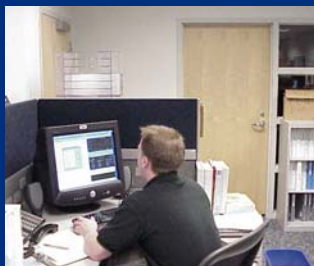

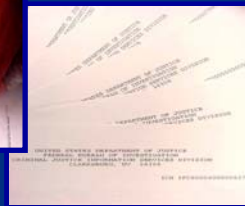
